Membership runs from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

<p>FULL MEMBERS</p> <p>\$65 (no insurance) for members NOT teaching in person in a private studio INCLUDING public school teachers and student teachers</p> <p>\$125 (with insurance) for members teaching in person in a private studio or traveling to teach.</p>	<p>Holds a Conservatory Associateship, and/or degree in Music, and/or achieved a RCM or equivalent grade 9 level including Harmony and History exams, or experienced teachers who are deemed as having equivalent qualifications by the Association in their chosen teaching area.</p> <p>May hold office locally. May represent MTA-NWT at CFMTA meetings.</p> <p>Uses R.M.T. designation.</p>
<p>ASSOCIATE MEMBER</p> <p>\$55 (no insurance) for members NOT teaching in person in a private studio INCLUDING public school teachers and student teachers</p> <p>\$115 (with insurance) for members teaching in person in a private studio or traveling to teach</p>	<p>Completed minimum Grade 8 including theory requirements through a recognized Conservatory program or equivalent training and/or experience specific to their teaching area.</p> <p>May hold office locally.</p> <p>Not entitled to use R.M.T. designation.</p>
<p>FRIENDS of the Society</p> <p>\$25</p>	<p>Supports the goals of the Association but does not teach.</p> <p>May hold office locally.</p> <p>Including individuals such as retired music teachers, not currently active music teachers, representatives of music festivals and other supporters of music.</p>
